

## Commonly used Conjunction

**and**

Used to join two similar words or statements to make it into a single sentence.

For example- **Eva and Jake are best friends.**

**but**

Used to join two different ideas into a single sentence.

For example- **The tree is old, but it is strong.**

**or**

Used to show that only one option is possible from the given options in the statement.

For example- **Do you want waffles or pancakes?**

**because**

Used to show the reason for an action

For example- **John ate all the cookies because he was very hungry.**

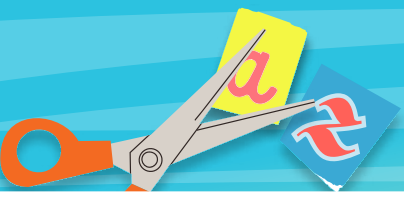
